## Calendar Year 2014 Recap

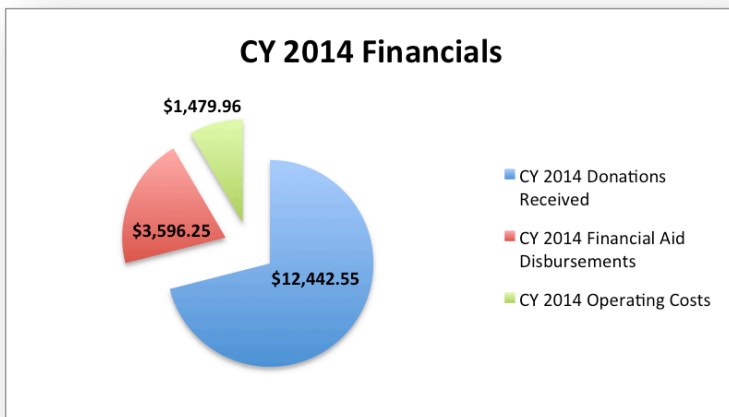
The 03XX Foundation had an extremely busy and successful 2014. We obtained our fiscal sponsor in November of 2013 and started working cases in spring of 2014. While we were founded on March 7, 2013 the core of our work supporting incoming cases didn't start until we had all of the business items in place to operate successfully. This included 501C3 fiscal sponsorship, Incorporation filing, IRS EIN, attorney, accountants, merchandise, a solid framework for receiving and reporting on all donations.



## 2014 Financials

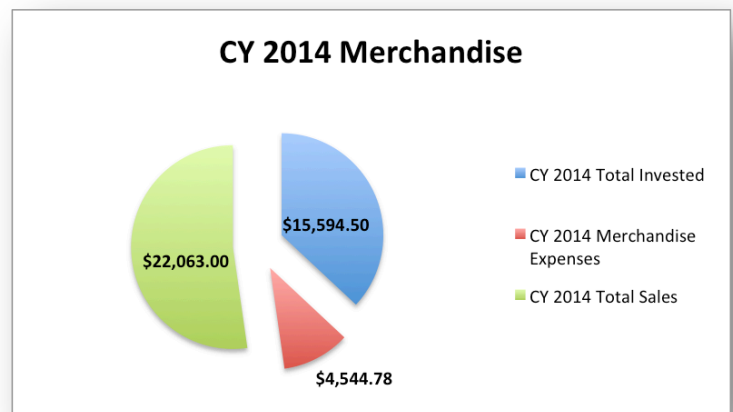
We started accepting donations at our launch event at Cookie's Tavern during the Marine Corps Birthday celebration November 10, 2013. Working with our accountant, and attorney, we evolved to accepting online tax-deductible donations via PayPal ([Donation@03xxfoundation.org](mailto:Donation@03xxfoundation.org)).

During our 501C3 fiscal sponsorship a percentage of all donations received went to the fiscal sponsor for attorney and accounting fees. This and our 501C3 filing fee with the IRS are accounted for in the Operating Costs portion of the chart.



## 2014 Merchandise

In late 2013 our Merchandise Vendor, 03 Designs and Apparel, donated \$1,000 to start the 03XX Foundation merchandise line. The foundation was required to deliver a percentage of all merchandise dollars to our 501C3 fiscal sponsor for operating overhead incurred (attorneys, accounting, tax professionals etc.). This is accounted for in the "Merchandise Expenses" in the chart. Other expenses incurred include things like shipping, comps for other non-profits like Purple Heart Baseball etc. All proceeds for any 03XX Foundation merchandise sold by 03 Designs and Apparel go directly to the 03XX Foundation.





## 2014 Case Management

We started accepting cases in the spring of 2014 to provide our Marine Corps Infantrymen and Navy Corpsmen with the services and programs we offer. Employment Services, Veterans Benefits Education and Advocacy, Financial and Budget Planning, and Emergency Financial Aid. Our team of Case Managers are 100% volunteers with 75% of them being active certified Veterans Service Officers (VSOs). During 2014 we were able to provide support on our entire catalog of service and program offerings. We were able to help families get off of the streets (living in their car), find employment, write professional resumes, find legal support, plan budgets, understand their VA benefits, process disability claim upgrades etc. Our entire staff is 100% volunteer and do this as a way to give back to our kind.
